

PUBLIC HEARING REPORT

MAY 13, 2020
FRANKLIN, LOUISIANA

The St. Mary Parish Council held a Public Hearing on this date with Chairman Dean S. Adams presiding and the following members present: Rev. Craig A. Mathews, Rodney Olander, Scott Ramsey, Leslie “Les” Rulf, Jr., James W. Bennett, Jr., Gwendolyn L. Hidalgo, and Kristi Prejeant Rink, M.D. Absent were J Ina, Patrick J. Hebert, and Mark A. Duhon.

The purpose of the Public Meeting will be to receive written and/or oral comments and to adopt the following ordinances:

An ordinance authorizing the incurring of debt and issuance of Six Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$600,000) of Certificates of Indebtedness, Series 2020 of the Parish of St. Mary, State of Louisiana; prescribing the form, terms, and conditions of such Certificates and providing for the payment thereof; authorizing an agreement with the Paying Agent, if required; and providing for other matters in connection therewith relative to the Franklin Sewer Plant Rehabilitation Project.

An Ordinance temporarily moving the location of Precincts 38 and 45 for the July 11, 2020 and August 15, 2020 elections.

An Ordinance prohibiting fishing along Cote Blanche Road and providing penalties for the violation of the same.

There were no written or oral comments received regarding the proposed ordinances.

There being no further business, Dr. Rink moved for adjournment. Rev. Mathews seconded the motion, which carried.
