

PUBLIC HEARING REPORT

SEPTEMBER 29, 2021
FRANKLIN, LOUISIANA

The St. Mary Parish Council held a Special Public Hearing on this date with Chairman Dean S. Adams presiding and the following members present: Craig A. Mathews, J Ina, Scott Ramsey, Leslie “Les” Rulf, Jr., Patrick J. Hebert, James W. Bennett, Jr. Mark A. Duhon, and Gwendolyn L. Hidalgo. Absent were Rodney Olander and Kristi Prejeant Rink, M.D.

The purpose of the Public Meeting will be to receive written and/or oral comments and to adopt the following ordinance:

An Ordinance amending and re-enacting Ordinance No. 2242 adopting the 2021 Combined Budgets of Revenues and Expenditures for the Parish of St. Mary, State of Louisiana.

There were no written and/or oral comments received regarding the proposed ordinance.

Chief Administrative Officer, Henry “Bo” LaGrange stated that the attached 2021 Amendments to the First Budget Amendment was discussed at the September 8, 2021 Parish Council Public Hearing. It includes an increase in the cost to house parish female prisoners in all municipal jails and also includes the cost of installing a camera system at the Animal Shelter.
