

## PUBLIC HEARING REPORT

FEBRUARY 9, 2022  
FRANKLIN, LOUISIANA

The St. Mary Parish Council held a Public Hearing on this date with Chairperson Kristi Prejeant Rink, M.D. presiding and the following members present: Craig A. Mathews, J Ina, Rodney Olander, Leslie “Les” Rulf, Jr., James W. Bennett, Jr., Mark A. Duhon, Dean S. Adams, and Gwendolyn L. Hidalgo. Absent were Scott Ramsey and Patrick J. Hebert.

The purpose of the Public Meeting will be to receive written and/or oral comments and to adopt the following ordinances:

An Ordinance authorizing the Parish of St. Mary to enter into a lease agreement with The United Houma Nation for the lease of office space located within the St. Mary Parish Government Annex Building at 301 Third Street, Morgan City, LA.

An Ordinance authorizing the Parish of St. Mary to enter into Servitude Agreements with Cleco Power, LLC granting a Right-of-Way for construction and maintenance of electric distribution and/or transmission facilities.

An Ordinance establishing a one hundred twenty day waiting period before re-introducing an Ordinance which has failed.

There were no written and/or verbal comments received regarding the proposed ordinances.

There being no further business, Mr. Olander moved for adjournment. Mrs. Hidalgo seconded the motion, which carried.
